1.	Cyber Security	December 2023	Ongoing Low Priority	<p>At the Board meeting in December 2023, the Board requested that a training session be provided on the cyber security arrangements for the Fund.</p> <p>This was initially delayed as STC had been updating its IT policies. Whilst this exercise has now completed, Officers need to find a slot within the training programme. The training programme has been stretched in 2024/25.</p>
2.	Risk Register Review	December 2024	July 2026 Low Priority	<p>At the Board meeting in December 2024, the Local Pension Board asked to review risk S14 (Failure to develop and introduce improved working practices as part of move to Modern Workplace programme, leads to a reduction in productivity) in 18 months' time to consider whether circumstances had changed.</p> <p>It is planned to bring this back to the Board in July 2026.</p>
